

Elements of Art Presentation Art 2, Art 3 and Art 4. Worth 100 points

The project.: To demonstrate their knowledge, the upper art students are going to pick an Art Element and give a short presentation to the Art 1 students. Students are expected to do some research on their topic and give a short ten minute presentation over the ITV system at a time that will be established in the next few weeks.

The Elements of Art are: Line, Value, Texture, Color, Space, Shape and Form. ‘

Steps for your Element presentation.(The presentation should be at least ten minutes in length.) (objectives and requirements)

1. I can... **Research an element.** There will be one day in class to work on the internet. Take fifteen minutes and research the elements. (Do not expect to be on a computer every day. Take notes.)
2. I can.... Pick one element to present.
3. I can... Write down the definition of the Element as it pertains to art.
4. I can.. Write down an explanation of the Element as it is used in creating art
5. I can... Find and obtain three pictures that present or show the Element well.
6. I can...Create some 8 x 11 “posters” with the information. Write legibly and large. This will be presented over the ITV system.
7. I can... Devise a short activity that all the students can do to reinforce the element that was just presented. This can be a game, a drawing, an individual or group activity or a competition.
8. I can..Practice the presentation. The presentation or “posters” may be different depending on the availability of a document camera. If there is a document camera, test your “posters” and make sure they can be read. If there is no document camera, the “posters” might have to be larger and the printing larger.
9. I can... **communicate the lesson in a clear and understandable way.**
10. I can... **be professional, prompt and prepared.**
11. All students will be filling in the bottom half of a sketch page with this information.
12. Mrs. Bailey will take care of the upper half at a later date.
